**Barlay Mill Lodge. Laurieston Road, Gatehouse of Fleet,
Dumfries and Galloway. DG7 2BD**



From the East: Gretna Green & Dumfries

- Travel along the A75 signposted Stranraer.
- By-pass Dumfries & Castle Douglas.
- Turn right off the A75 onto the B727 at a staggered crossroads at the bottom of a long hill signposted Gatehouse of Fleet.
- Travel approximately 3 miles along this road then as you enter the village, turn right onto Laurieston Road (signposted golf course).

From the West: Stranraer

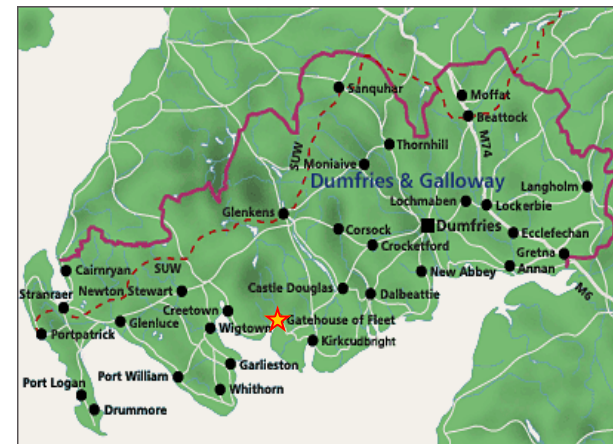
- Travel along the A75 signposted Dumfries.
- Pass Newton Stewart.
- Leave the A75 onto the B796 signposted Gatehouse of Fleet.
- Travel over the bridge and through the village centre.
- At the end of the village, by the war memorial and pond, turn left onto Laurieston Road (signposted golf course).

From Laurieston Road turning: All arrivals

- Travel along Laurieston Road, passing the tennis courts and golf club on right hand side.
- The lodge is on the right hand side of the road. It is a white building approximately 50m after the golf course car park. A tarmaced drive is to the right of the property.
- The front door is up a slight ramp by the black railings adjacent to the road.
